


Allpsoidal 10 DMX




How To Change The Gobo




At first, put the gobo by hand as the arrow into the gobo gel splint, and insert the gobo gel splint into the slot of the unit, please turn the hand knob to left or right in order to take out gobo gel splint.


Note: The diameter of the inner and outer rings of the gobo, the size and thickness of the gobo gel splint are shown in the following figure:



How To Change The Focus Lens



At first, please push the screws on both side of the fixture by hand as the arrow, and move away the focus lens silently by hand as the arrow.




Then insert the focus lens as the arrow silently, and insert the screws in place by hand as the arrow, and fasten the lens.

Main Function

To select any of the given functions, press the **MENU** button up to when the required one is showing on the display. Select the function by **ENTER** button and the display will blink. Use the **DOWN/UP** button to change the mode. Once the required mode has been selected, press the **ENTER** button to setup, to go back to the functions without any change press the **MENU** button again. Hold and press the **MENU** button about one second or wait for one minute to exit the menu mode.

The main functions are showing below:



Bਰਰ DMX Address

Press the **MENU** button up to when the **Bada** is shown on the display. Press the **ENTER** button and the display will blink. Use the **DOWN** and **UP** button to change the value from **1** to **512**. Once the mode has been selected, press the **ENTER** button to setup, to go back to the functions without any change press the **MENU** button again. Hold and press the **MENU** button about one second or wait for one minute to exit the menu mode.

Channel Mode

Press the **MENU** button to show **Thid** on the display. Press the **ENTER** button and the display will blink. Use the **DOWN** and **UP** button to select **1ch** or **2ch**. Once the mode has been selected, press the **ENTER** button to setup, to go back to the functions without any change press the **MENU** button again. Hold and press the **MENU** button about one second or wait for one minute to exit the menu mode.

리하는 DMX State

Press the **MENU** button up to when the **GISE** is shown on the display. Press the **ENTER** button and the display will blink. Use the **DOWN** and **UP** button to select the **BLRd** (blackout mode) or **LRSE** (last state). Once the mode has been selected, press the **ENTER** button to setup, to go back to the functions without any change press the **MENU** button again. Hold and press the **MENU** button about one second or wait for one minute to exit the menu mode.


Dimmer Mode

Press the MENU button up to when the line is shown on the display.

Press the ENTER button and the display will blink.. Use the DOWN and UP button to select the line (dimmer 1), line (dimmer 2), line (dimmer 3) or line (dimmer 4). Once the mode has been selected,

press the **ENTER** button to setup, to go back to the functions without any change press the **MENU** button again. Hold and press the **MENU** button about one second or wait for one minute to exit the menu mode.

Dimmer Modes



Mode 1(Optically Linear):

The increase in light intensity appears to be linear as DMX value is increased.

Mode 2(Square Law):

Light intensity control is finer at low levels and coarser at high levels.

Mode 3(Inverse Square Law):

Light intensity control is coarser at low levels and finger at high levels.

Mode 4(S-curve):

Light intensity control is finger at low levels and high levels and coarser at medium levels.

LED LFD

Press the **MENU** button up to when the LPB is shown on the display.

Press the **ENTER** button and the display will blink. Use the **DOWN** and **UP** button to select **DOWN** or **DEF (Off)**, Once the mode has been

selected, press the **ENTER** button to setup, to go back to the functions without any change press the **MENU** button again. Hold and press the **MENU** button about one second or wait for one minute to exit the menu mode.

Display Inversion

Press the MENU button until (a) is blinking on the display. Use the DOWN and UP button to select (a) is (normal) or (inverse). Once the mode has been selected, press the ENTER button to setup, to go back to the functions without any change press the MENU button again. Hold and press the MENU button about one second or wait for one minute to exit the menu mode.

데무크U Manual Mode

Press the **MENU** button up to when the IRAU is shown on the display. Press the **ENTER** button and the display will blink. Use the **DOWN** and **UP** button to select IIII (dimmer). Once the mode has been selected, press the **ENTER** button to setup the value from **0** to **255**, to go back to the functions without any change press the **MENU** button again. Hold and press the **MENU** button about one second or wait for one minute to exit the menu mode.

EBSE Auto Test

Press the **MENU** button up to when the **EPSE** is blinking on the display. Press the **ENTER** button and the unit will run the built-in programmer for self-test. To go back to the functions press the **MENU** button.

Fh-5 Fixture Hours

Press the **MENU** button up to when the **Fhrs** is blinking on the display. Press the **ENTER** button and the display will show the using hours of the unit. To go back to the functions press the **MENU** button.

Software Version

Press the **MENU** button up to when the LELL is blinking on the display. Press the **ENTER** button and the display will show the version of software of the unit. To go back to the functions press the **MENU** button.

DMX Controller

By using a universal DMX controller to control the units, you will need to set DMX address from 1 to 512 so that the units can receive DMX signal. Press the MENU button up to when the DMX Address is showing on the display. Pressing the ENTER button and the display will blink. Use the DOWN/UP button to change the DMX512 address. Once the address has

been selected, press the ENTER button to setup, to go back to the

functions without any change press the **MENU** button again. Hold and press the **MENU** button about one second or wait for one minute to exit the menu mode.

Troubleshooting

The fixture does not work, no light

- 1. Check the connection of power and main fuse.
- 2. Measure the mains voltage on the main connector.

Fixture Cleansing

The cleaning of internal and external optical lenses and/or mirrors must be carried out periodically to optimize light output. Cleaning frequency depends on the environment in which the fixture operates: damp, smoky or particularly dirty surrounding can cause greater accumulation of dirt on the unit's optics.

- Clean with soft cloth and use normal glass to clean liquid.
- Always dry the parts carefully.
- Clean the external optics at least every 20 days. Clean the internal optics at least every 30 days.
